Product components

1. Food pusher
2. Cylinder (drum housing)
3. Base
4. Suction lock
5. Suction base
6. Crank handle
7. Handle lock (knob)
8. Fine grater drum
9. Slicer drum
10. Coarse grater drum

Drum functions and best uses

Slicer drum

Best for: Cucumbers, zucchini, potatoes, carrots, beetroot, radish



Fine grater drum

Best for: Nuts, walnuts, chocolate, cheese, crackers, garlic



Coarse grater drum

Best for: Cheese, carrots, potatoes, zucchini, beetroot

Not suitable for: Frozen fruits, very hard vegetables, onions



Assembly and operation

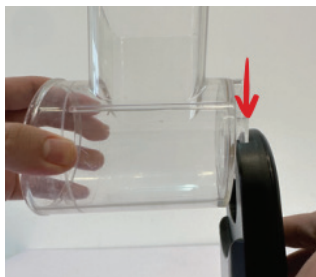
Step 1: Secure the base

Place the grater on a clean, dry countertop. Press down the suction lock firmly to secure the base in place.



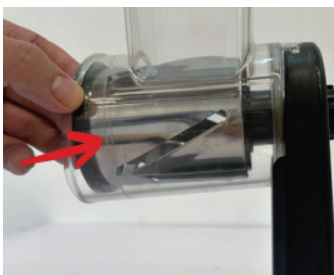
Step 2: Install the cylinder

Align the cylinder with the groove on the base and slide it into position until fully seated.



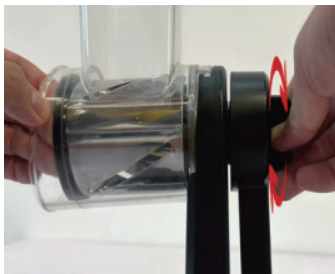
Step 3: Insert the drum blade

Select the desired drum blade and slide it into the cylinder, ensuring it passes completely through the opening.



Step 4: Attach the handle

Hold the drum blade firmly with one hand. Insert the crank handle into the drum and turn the handle lock clockwise until fully secured.



Step 5: Start grating

1. Place food into the cylinder.
2. Use the food pusher to press ingredients down gently.
3. Turn the crank handle clockwise to begin grating.

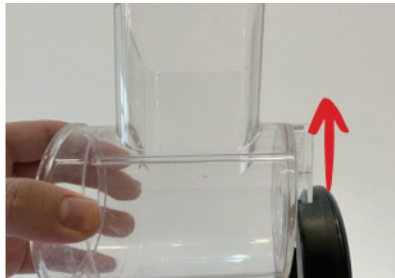


Disassembly instructions

1. Hold the drum blade securely and turn the handle lock counterclockwise to remove the crank handle and drum.



2. Pull the cylinder upward to remove it from the base.



3. Lift the suction lock to release the base from the benchtop.



Cleaning and maintenance

- Disassemble all parts before cleaning.
- Hand washing is recommended for the cylinder. Removable graters are dishwasher safe.
- Dry all components thoroughly before reassembly or storage.
- For best performance, use fresh, firm ingredients and clean the grater immediately after use.
